


ReGeneration 26







ReGeneration 26 connects thousands of young people through collaboration, creativity, and exchange - sparking fresh perspectives and shared learning for a thriving future.

It's more than a conference, it's a catalyst. A two-day burst of youth energy, imagination, and connection. Onsite and across the globe

Students from around the world will come together to explore how we can learn, live, and lead in ways that help both people and the planet thrive. Through creativity, dialogue, and shared experiences, participants will sense, seek, shape, and share new possibilities for a regenerative future.

Under the soaring bamboo structures of Green School Bali over 40 nationalities will connect in person, while the ReGeneration Circles invite schools everywhere to host their own gatherings, forming a constellation of hope and action.

Program Outline day 1

Early Morning: ReGeneration Provocation - movement,

connection, questions

A movement-based opening that brings all participants together through rhythm and connection. Provocations encourage curiosity, empathy, and imagination, setting the tone for collaboration and courage.

Designed for each age group, Explorers (6-12 years) and Catalysts (13-18 years), Climate Cafes offer hopeful and empowering spaces for reflection, dialogue, pledges and calls to action beyond the bamboo buildings.

Youth Voices in Action

Catalysts come together for a screening of Future Council, a fresh film spotlighting young changemakers reimagining leadership and collective action in a rapidly changing world.

Facilitated by Clover Hogan and a lineup of inspiring young changemakers, this panel-style forum blends conversation, performance, provocation and an open dialogue exploring what it truly means to act - not wait - for change.

Sensing and Seeking - onsite in Bali



Program outline day 2



Morning: Connection Circles & Creative Explorations

Reconnection and preparation to turn insight into impact. An all-ages day starts with creating organic art sculptures, games for change, poetry, music, movement circles and more.



Late Morning: Lightning Talks - Ideas that Spark

Short, powerful TED-style talks where young speakers share their projects, solutions, and stories from nature. Quick, bright, and full of hope — Lightning Talks prove that small sparks can light big fires.



Afternoon: Festival of Futures a celebration of hope

Markets, music, hands-on activities , demonstrations and celebrations. This joyful finale reminds participants: this is not an ending, but a beginning.



Event Output: The ReGeneration Call to Action

Culminating in a youth-generated statement, a collective message will capture the hopes, commitments, and invitations of young people (from across the globe, virtually and in person) for a regenerative future.

A little more detail

It's all about the young people:

This event is organised and led by young people, for young people. Middle and High School students from around the world are invited to participate and contribute.

Regenerative Design shapes the program:

Participants journey through the Four S's of Regenerative Design:

- Sensing: We notice what the living world shows and hides
- · Seeking: We ask big questions to understand and respond
- Shaping: We create with the living world to help life flourish
- Storytelling: We share what happens so connections can grow

An inclusive and evolving program:

The in-person experience is being programed by a youth leadership team and is still evolving. The program outline provides a Lightning Talks, panel discussions, and the Festival of Futures will be streamed and shared globally.

Partner schools are invited to join the ReGeneration Circle by hosting their own Climate Cafés in parallel with the in-person event. Creating space for local dialogue and action and forming a shared digital tapestry of youth vision and courage.

Bring a small delegation of Middle/High School students (and their teachers or chaperones) to Bali, Indonesia, on 16–17 April 2026 to connect with 1,000 peers from around the world to share ideas, build solutions, and imagine regenerative futures together. Opportunities to lead a session, give a talk or join a panel are also open.

3. Join the ReGeneration Circle

Take part from wherever you are. In partnership with Force of Nature, students can join a free Junior Facilitator Training and host their own Climate Café - a safe, empowering space for honest dialogue, reflection, and collective action. All resources and guidance are provided, making it easy to get involved.

Your students' voices and insights will contribute to the **ReGeneration** Call to Action - a shared declaration from young people worldwide, amplifying their hopes, priorities, and demands for a thriving future.



Experience ReGeneration 26 in Bali

We're here to help your school take part in the way that works best for you. Here's how we can support your journey to Bali:

Be Part of the Experience: Bring a small delegation of students and teachers to Bali for an unforgettable two days on 17-18 April 2026. While we're unable to cover international travel, selected school groups will be eligible for two nights of complimentary accommodation in Bali. All participants will enjoy free lunches and snacks throughout the event, and to honour every journey made, we'll plant mangrove seedlings to help offset travel-related carbon emissions.

Participation is Free: There is no registration fee for students or teachers/chaperones, but places are limited. We encourage you to register early or join a virtual information session to learn more.

Fundraising and Travel Support: We can provide a fundraising toolkit to help your school support student travel and participation.

Extend Your Experience: Add a 2–10 day <u>Green Camp Bali</u> experience before or after the event. Together, we can design a program that fits your learning goals and spirit of adventure.
