Admissions Fees

Application and Registration Fees:

Total Admission Fee (Non-refundable) 40,000,000 IDR

All applications must be submitted with the Application Fee. An application fee is required for each enrollment cycle and is not refundable even if a place is not provided to the student. Once the Application fee has been paid and all application materials have been submitted, the application review process commences.

The registration fee is payable once and is invoiced upon acceptance of an enrollment offer to reserve the place or to be added to the waitlist pool. The registration fee is not refundable should the parent withdraw their application. The registration fee remains valid for one (1) year if. If the enrolment is deferred beyond one year (two semesters), a new registration fee will be applied.

Refundable Deposit:

Refundable Deposit 30,000,000 IDR/child

Green School Bali holds the Refundable Deposit for the duration of the student's enrolment. When the student leaves Green School Bali, the Deposit is refundable in accordance with the School's withdrawal deadlines and refund policies, subject to any outstanding payments owed and shall be without interest. In the event of withdrawal earlier than the minimum enrollment period of 12 months, or in case of late withdrawal notice after the Intention to Continue deadline, the deposit will not be refunded

Payment Terms

To support families with different financial planning needs, Green School Bali continues to offer flexible tuition payment options for the Academic Year 2026/2027. Parents may choose to settle fees through annual (A), Semester (B), or Termly (C) instalment arrangements, in accordance with the school's published payment schedule. There are 3 payment options for the tuition fee:

A. Annual payment

The annual tuition fee is settled in full no later than the payment deadline, 15th of April.

B. Semester payments (2 instalments per year)

For families paying by semester (2 instalments), the 70% of the tuition is due for the 1st instalment, and 30% remains for the 2nd instalment. For all families paying by semester, the tuition fee is 3% higher for the entire year.

C. Termly payments (4 instalments per year)

For all families paying by term (4 instalments per year), the tuition fee is 8% higher for the entire year. The termly payment plan is available only for existing families who have already completed the minimum enrolment period of 12 months.

Please note:

Paying by semester or by term does not mean that enrolment is committed by a single semester or term, nor that fees are prorated for time out of School during enrolment. See below for details on withdrawals after the minimum enrolment period of 12 months.

For the new families, the payment deadline will be adjusted based on their admission date, and the invoice due date will be aligned accordingly.

Minimum Enrollment Period

Green School Bali requires students to enrol for a minimum of 12 months, except for Early Years, which requires a minimum enrolment of one semester, and the fees will follow the payment semester schedule. Withdrawal before the end of the minimum enrolment period does not allow for the refund of any deposit, tuition or fees paid. For a 6-month enrolment period in Early Years, a 10% loading on the Semester tuition fee applies.

Sibling Discount

For families with more than one child attending Green School, sibling discounts apply.

Additional School Activity Fee Policy (High School)

The High School programme at Green School Bali includes an additional fee of Rp **7,250,000** per student to cover High School Service Trips, which are an integral part of the learning experience. Additionally, throughout the year, students have the opportunity to participate in optional activities such as specialised sports tournaments and unique experiential programmes. These activities come at an additional cost and are designed to further enrich student learning.

This fee will be included in the **Second billing cycle**.



Late Payment Fee.

Green School Bali will impose a late payment fee for overdue fees after the payment deadline as set out in the invoice. Overdue payments or failing to make payments in accordance with the existing payment schedule, a 10% surcharge will be applied, along with an administration fee of IDR 500,000 per invoice.

Miscellaneous Fees

Every Green School Bali family plays a role in supporting a new generation of Indonesian changemakers by contributing to the Local Scholar Program. The mandatory levy applies to each Green School family (not per child), and is payable annually. Our vibrant parent community is supported by the Green School Parent Association (GSPA) along with The Bridge (the School's parent co-working, co-creation and co-learning space). This mandatory payment entitles up to two parents membership for The Bridge.

Additional Student Support

It is crucial to share any information regarding identified support needs during the application and enrollment stages to ensure appropriate support for children's well-being. By endorsing this Agreement, you acknowledge the disclosure of specific needs and any prior documents, such as Individual Student Plans (ISPs), Individual Education Plans (IEPs), Education Support Plans (ESPs), Personalised Learning Plans (PLPs), Student Support Plans (SSPs), Academic Support Plans (ASPs), Behaviour Support Plans (BSPs), Behaviour Education Plans (BEPs), Psychology Reports, Transition Plans, or similar reports from previous schools, educators, and psychologists during the application process. If any such assessments are undertaken during a child's enrolment, these reports must also be provided to the school. It is also essential to recognise that support needs may evolve, and corresponding service charges could be adjusted, either increasing or decreasing, over time.

If a student requires a level of support that aligns with the standards outlined in our policies and as determined by the School educational leadership and student support teams, the school will be charged for the time and resources expended in managing and delivering that support. The school retains the authority to mandate the implementation of an ISP plan and the associated termly payment. Additionally, the school maintains the prerogative to define the specific nature of this support on a case-by-case basis, considering the holistic needs of each student.

English Language Learners (ELL)

Students with additional English language learning needs will be assessed using an online assessment WIDA.

WIDA, which stands for World-Class Instructional Design and Assessment, provides English language proficiency standards and assessments for English language learners (ELLs). The WIDA proficiency levels, also known as language proficiency levels, are used to describe the English language development of ELLs. These levels help educators understand and address the language proficiency of students. The WIDA proficiency levels are typically designated as follows:

Level 1: Entering (EN) - Students at this level have minimal English language proficiency. They may understand and produce basic vocabulary and phrases, but communication is limited.

Level 2: Emerging (EM) - Students at this level show an expanding understanding of English, with increased vocabulary and ability to communicate in simple sentences. However, their language proficiency is still developing.

Level 3: Developing (DEV) - At this level, students demonstrate a developing ability to use English for academic purposes. They can understand and use more complex language structures, though some support may still be needed.

Level 4: Expanding (EXP) - Students at this level are expanding their ability to use English in more complex academic contexts. They can understand and produce language with increasing complexity and independence.

Level 5: Bridging (BR) - At the Bridging level, students are approaching English language proficiency comparable to their peers who are native English speakers. They can engage in grade-appropriate academic tasks with support.

It's important to note that these levels are part of a continuum, and students will progress through them at their own pace. Students entering High School will have to be at level 4 or 5 composite to enter and access the program.

Learning and/or Behaviour Support 'Intensive' Level of Support Required

One-on-One Aide

If the school determines that a student requires a full-time student support tutor or aide, to access our learning program, it is the sole responsibility of the carers to locate and bear the expenses associated with such educational support. While Green School Bali will assist in identifying a tutor whenever feasible, the ultimate responsibility for this arrangement rests with the carers or guardians. The school and the carers or guardians will jointly decide on the final assignment of an aide as the school reserves the right for Child Protection to approve all individuals working with children on campus.

Fee Payment Options

All payments must be made in Indonesian Rupiah in the form of bank transfer, local cheque, and cash.
