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## 1. Background

ReGeneration26 – Global Youth Conference is a global conference initiated by students of Green School as a collaborative platform for young people to express their creativity, foster dialogue, and respond to pressing global challenges, particularly environmental issues.

This event is designed as a safe and inclusive space where students can exchange ideas, build cross-cultural connections, and develop meaningful collaborations toward a regenerative and sustainable future.

The conference will be accessible both onsite at Green School Bali and online through the ReGeneration Circle format, enabling broader international participation and engagement.

## 2. Vision and Mission

### 2.1 Vision

To build a global network of young leaders who take collective action toward environmental restoration and a sustainable future.

### 2.2 Mission

- ❖ To provide a platform for young people to voice their ideas and innovative solutions.
- ❖ To encourage inclusive, reflective, and empathetic dialogue.
- ❖ To cultivate student leadership through experiential and practice-based learning.
- ❖ To connect local initiatives with global movements through cross-border collaboration.



### 3. Program Concept

ReGeneration26 – Global Youth Conference adopts an approach that expands beyond conventional sustainability by applying the **4S's of Regenerative Design** as its primary learning framework:

- ❖ **Sensing** – Observing and deeply understanding the dynamics of the world around us.
- ❖ **Seeking** – Exploring critical questions to better understand challenges and identify meaningful responses.
- ❖ **Shaping** – Designing solutions that are aligned with natural systems to support long-term sustainability.
- ❖ **Storytelling** – Sharing processes, insights, and outcomes to strengthen collective understanding and global collaboration.

This framework encourages participants not only to analyse issues but also to develop practical and context-based solutions that can be implemented within their own communities.

### 4. Forms and Participation Scheme

#### 4.1 Onsite Participation at Green School Bali

ReGeneration26 – Global Youth Conference will be held over two days, **Thursday and Friday, 16–17 April 2026, at Green School Bali**. The event is expected to welcome students from more than 40 countries, with approximately 1,000 middle and high school participants.

Each participating school is invited to send a delegation of **up to 10 students**, accompanied by **one to three supervising teachers** (depending on the group size).



### Facilities provided:

- Free limited shared-accommodation space at Green Camp, Bali
- Lunch and light refreshments throughout the event.

Participating schools are responsible for arranging transportation to and from the venue.

As part of our commitment to sustainability, each participant's attendance will be offset through the planting of one mangrove seedling at the Taman Hutan Raya Ngurah Rai in Bali, contributing to efforts to reduce the carbon footprint generated by travel.

Delegates will have the opportunity to present their sustainability and innovation-based projects through a curated platform called the **Lightning Talk**, which forms one of the key segments of ReGeneration26 – Global Youth Conference. Presentation slots will be selection-based (further details will be outlined in the following section). All other program activities are open to all registered delegates.

## 4.2 Accommodation at Green Camp Bali

School delegations travelling from outside Bali, or those located at least three hours away by road, will be eligible for **complimentary shared-accommodation at Green Camp Bali**. This initiative is intended to offer participants the opportunity to experience living close to nature while engaging more deeply with the values of the conference.

Accommodation will be available for check-in at **2:00 PM on 15 April 2026**, with check-out scheduled at **6:00 PM on 17 April 2026**.

Green Camp features a variety of bamboo-constructed buildings set within a natural environment (you will hear birds chirping and sounds of insects all day).

The structures are designed with natural ventilation systems, and fans are provided (air conditioning is not available). Accommodation types include lodges, houses with two to four rooms, and dormitories, most of which are equipped with bunk beds.



To encourage intercultural exchange and collaboration, students will be grouped with participants from different schools. Accommodation will be arranged by gender, meaning each housing unit will be assigned to a single gender only.

**For accompanying teachers**, a shared dormitory arrangement will also be provided, separated by gender. Final sleeping arrangements will be confirmed and communicated upon check-in.

Please note that space at Green Camp is limited and will be allocated on a first-confirmed basis, determined by the submission of the completed delegation registration form.

As the camp is situated in a natural forest environment, participants should expect close interaction with nature. It is common to encounter insects, mosquitoes, spiders, squirrels, and various species of birds. While the facilities are well maintained and safety protocols are in place, we encourage all guests to come prepared and embrace the experience of living in an open, nature-immersed setting.

If accommodation at Green Camp reaches full capacity, we have partnered with a local hotel and will arrange alternative lodging accordingly. However, we strongly encourage participants to stay at Green Camp to fully experience the spirit of the Green School community and immerse themselves in the surrounding natural environment.

### Details of Offering:

1. **Buffet Dinner (2 nights – 15 & 16 April)**

IDR 250,000++ per person (for two dinners)

Payment to be made to the ReGeneration26 Committee. The payment can be made during your arrival.

2. **Extended Stay at Green Camp**

For check-in before 15 April or check-out after 17 April, the rate **starts** from **IDR 900,000++ per person per night** (including last breakfast on 18 April).

## 5. Main Program Highlights

1. **Climate Cafés (facilitated by Force of Nature)**

A safe and reflective dialogue space where meaningful change begins through conversation rather than confrontation. This session is **also designed for schools outside Bali and Indonesia that participate remotely**, allowing students to engage in thoughtful discussions on global challenges in a supportive environment.

2. **Lightning Talks**

Short student presentations showcasing innovative project ideas with the potential to spark meaningful environmental and social change. Selected participants will present solutions that demonstrate creativity, critical thinking, and real-world



impact.

### 3. Panel Discussions and Youth Keynote

Insightful sessions led by young changemakers and invited speakers supported by UNESCO. These discussions aim to amplify youth voices while providing diverse perspectives on sustainability, leadership, and regenerative futures.

### 4. Hands-On Workshops

Interactive workshops facilitated by experienced practitioners, educators, and sustainability experts from diverse fields. These sessions provide participants with practical tools, methodologies, and real-world case studies that can be directly applied within their own schools and communities.

Topics may range from regenerative design, climate action strategies, and systems thinking to student leadership and project-based learning.

### 5. Festival of Futures

A celebratory showcase of ideas, innovations, and collaborative solutions for the future. This segment highlights student-driven initiatives and collective visions developed throughout the conference.

## 6. Registration

To participate in the ReGeneration26 – Global Youth Conference, schools are invited to complete the following steps:

### 6.1 Submission of Expression of Interest

Schools are required to complete an online Registration Form to formally express their



initial interest in participating.

The form includes the following information:

- ❖ Type of participation (in-person or online)
  - **If you select online participation**, it means your school will host a **Climate Café** within your own community. A member of our team will contact you to provide further information, coordination support, and facilitation guidelines.
- ❖ Number of student delegates and accompanying teachers to Bali. Schools are allowed to bring up to **10 students aged 12-18 (middle and high school students) and 1-3 chaperone teachers**.
- ❖ Confirmation on staying shared-accommodation at The Green Camp, Bali
- ❖ Interest in participating in the Lightning Talk session

- Provide a clear title and detailed description of the proposed talk
- Submit a short speaker biography (used for stage introduction)
- Share information about completed or ongoing projects, research, or actions related to the topic
- Confirm availability for a short online interview

#### Timeline

- Application deadline: **15 March 2026**
- Interviews completed by: **end of March 2026**
- Speaker confirmation: Shortly after interviews are completed



*Please note:*

- Maximum talk duration: **5-7 minutes**
- Talks must be delivered by students
- Speakers will present in groups of four, followed by a 10-minute Q&A session
- Priority will be given to talks that focus on issues relevant to young people and demonstrate tangible action or impact.
